
SAFETY

SETTING A GOOD EXAMPLE.



> Play it safe.

When you're out chasing the catch of the day, remember that safely controlling your boat comes first. Standing in a moving boat is dangerous, as is sitting on the gunwales, seat backs or pedestal seats. Never leave the helm unattended when the boat is underway. Safely stow any gear you're not using. And always use proper lighting when fishing at night.



> Who has the right of way?

Always give way to slower or less maneuverable boats, staying clear and passing to the stern. In crossing situations, the boat to the right from the 12 o'clock to the 4 o'clock position has the right of way. It should hold course and speed. The other boat must make whatever adjustments necessary to pass behind it. If you choose to pass a slower boat ahead of you, be sure to take care to keep out of its way. And never follow directly behind a boat towing skiers or tubers — if they fall, you could overtake them in a matter of seconds.

Controlling your boat always comes first.

> Anchoring your boat.

ALWAYS anchor your boat from the bow — NEVER from the stern. With the squared transom and the weight of the engine, anchoring from the stern could allow the current to pull your boat under water.



> Know the weather.


Never leave the dock without checking your local weather forecast. Severe weather can develop rapidly, so while you're out, pay attention to any changes. Things to watch out for include rapidly approaching clouds, a sudden drop in temperature and a sudden change in wind direction or speed.

Always carry a wearable PFD for each passenger.

One for everyone.

Federal law requires that you carry at least one wearable (Type I, II or III) Personal Flotation Device (PFD) for each passenger, as well as one throwable (Type IV) PFD. There are many different styles, designed to be comfortable for every activity. And most importantly, each passenger should have one that fits properly — especially children and non-swimmers.

FISHING TIPS

TIPS FOR GREAT FISHING.

Welcome to Starcraft's 2005 tips to help you make the most of your fishing trips. This year, we're getting to the heart of the matter with two main categories: Finding



In the simplest terms, finding fish means finding where their food is. In streams and rivers, food is concentrated in currents, but in lakes and other still waters, you have to know the terrain, or structure. Here are some great places to start.

- 1. Inlets
- 2. Boulders
- 3. Rocky points
- 4. Cliffs and drop-offs
- 5. Coves
- 6. Underwater trees
- 7. Shade
- 8. Lily pads
- 9. Weed beds

In coastal areas, fishing is best when the tides are moving in or out. During an outgoing tide, you'll want to be just outside harbors and creek mouths, where bait and fish will pass as the tide recedes.

> Time and temperature.

When's the best time to fish? Most experienced anglers go looking for game fish at dawn and at dusk - and on cloudy days that look like dawn and dusk. Many people believe that weather, temperature, moon phases and barometric pressure




effect how fish will bite. If you're fishing for a particular species, it's well worth the time to learn the habits of that fish in the water where you're fishing. Keeping a detailed log can also help you establish the patterns of your favorite game fish.

> Taking the bait.

There are two main approaches to catching fish: live bait and artificial lures. Preferred baits vary widely from species to species and from region to region. They can include chunks of fish (cut bait). specially formulated prepared baits. doughballs, shrimp, clams, leeches, insects and many more. Worms and minnows are perhaps the most popular, and may be used in different ways, depending on your style of fishing.



THREADING A WORM



THREADING A MINNOW

You may either thread the hook through the body of the worm, or you may completely hide the hook by threading several worms on the shank and covering the point.

Threading a minnow depends on your method of fishing. Through the back works best with a bobber, while through the lips is better for trolling. Threading the minnow through the tail allows it to continue to swim. and attract fish.



The most basic way to thread a plastic worm is the Texas rig - with the hook threaded through the head of the worm, out the side and then back in to bury the point. This prevents the rig from snagging on weeds or underwater structure. A deep-water variation is the Carolina rig, which allows the worm to float freely along the bottom. You simply put a sinker on your line above a swivel, and tie a leader to both the swivel and the eye of the book.

> How to tie an improved clinch knot:

- 1. Thread through eye of hook.
- through the eye of the hook
- 2. Five tame around line.
- 3. Pass and through loop.



- 4. Pass and through large loop.
- 5. Tighten and him and.

- 1. Thread the end of the line and pull it back toward the line.
- 2. Make 5 or more wraps around the line.
- 3. Pass the end through the first loop nearest the eye.
- 4. Thread the end back through the loop you just made.
- Pull the hook and line tight and dip excess line from the knot.

> The basics of lures.

The advantage of fishing with lures is that you may reuse them again and again. However, it's important that you work them so they resemble live bait - with jerks, twitches, jigging and swimming motions.



Plugs and crankbaits are designed to be cast out and reeled back in. They may stay on the surface or dive when retrieved, depending on their shape. A long lip on a crankbait will cause it to dive deeper, while a shorter lip will keep it shallow.

Jigs may be cast or trolled some are designed to stay close to the surface while others sink quickly to the bottom.



Spoons may be designed for either casting or trolling. Weedless styles are ideal for fishing around weed beds for walleye and bass.

Spinners are popular because they come in many different styles for many types of fishing.



Spinnerbalts are designed for fishing at a variety of depths, primarily for bass, walleye and pike.

Buzzbaits churn the water to attract fish on the surface.





PREPARING YOUR FISH.

>What could be more fun than cooking the day's catch on the grill?

Whether your favorite fishing spot is miles offshore or just beyond the lily pads, there's nothing more satisfying than turning the day's catch into a delicious meal. Here are two of our favorite recipes for grilled salmon. Enjoy.





Grilled Salmon with Mango Salsa

Salmon Ingredients:

- 3 4 lb. Atlantic salmon, boneless fillets
- 2 Tbs. + 1/2 tsp. seasoning salt
- · 1 Tbs. olive oil

Mango Salsa Ingredients:

- · 1 ripe mango, peeled, seeded and diced 1/4 inch
- 1/4 C. diced red onion
- 2 chipotle peppers, diced
- · Juice of 1 lime
- 1 Tbs. chopped fresh cilantro
- · 2 Tbs. olive oil
- Salt
- Freshly cracked pepper

Grilled Salmon with Mango Salsa Preparation:

Season the salmon fillets on all sides with seasoning salt, pressing the spices into the flesh. Brush salmon lightly with olive oil and set aside. Meanwhile, prepare the mango salsa. In a bowl, combine mango, red onion, chipotle peppers, cilantro, olive oil, lime juice and seasonings. Set aside. Pre-heat grill to medium high. On a seasoned grill, cook the salmon for 6 to 8 minutes per side until lightly charred and just cooked through. Serve with mango salsa and pan-fried baby new potatoes.

Asian Grilled Salmon

For 4 salmon fillets, whisk together the following ingredients for a marinade:

- 1/3 C. soy sauce
- 1/4 C. orange juice
- 1/4 C. lime juice
- 1/4 C. honey
- 1 clove garlic
- 1 Tbs. grated fresh ginger
- * 2 Tbs. chopped fresh cilantro
- 1 chopped scallion

Marinate fillets in the refrigerator for 15 – 30 minutes, turning occasionally. Preheat grill to medium heat and oil the grill rack. Place fillets on the grill and brush with remaining marinade. Grill for 12 – 15 minutes per inch of thickness — or until fish flakes with a fork. Serve with grilled asparagus or sautéed green beans.



IT ALL STARTS WITH GETTING THERE.

Take time to get comfortable trailering your boat, and your day on the water will get off to a great start.

- . Before your first trip, practice maneuvering in an empty parking lot.
- · On the road, drive slower than you normally would.
- Increase your following distance and allow for longer braking time — even if your trailer is equipped with brakes.
- · Take wider turns.
- Never remove the bow safety chain and winch line until you are in launch position.
- ALWAYS remember to replace your transom drain plugs!!!



Tips for a smooth launch.

Always stop in a parking area near the ramp to prepare your boat for launch without blocking traffic. Use the following checklist to help it all go smoothly.

In the parking area:

- Remove the trailer-to-motor supports.
- · Remove tie-downs.
- Load and store the gear you want to bring on your boat.
- Check all systems, including your boat's engine, blower, bilge pump and lights.
- · Don't forget to insert the drain plug.

At the ramp - in launch position:

- · Disconnect the bow safety chain hook from the bow eye.
- Disconnect trailer wiring from your vehicle.
- Proceed with launching instructions for your type of trailer
 — located in the trailer's owner's manual.





GLOSSARY

A GLOSSARY OF BOATING AND WATERSPORTS TERMS.

Adrift: drifting loose, not on moorings or towline

Aft: toward the rear of the boat

Anchor: to secure a boat to the bottom

Aweigh: the position of anchor as it is raised clear of the bottom

Baitfish: small fish often eaten by predators

Batten Down: secure hatches and loose objects both within the hull and on deck

Beam: the width at the widest part of the boat

Bilge: the area in the bottom of the boat where seepage collects

Bow: the front of the boat

Buoy: a floating navigational marker

Chine: the part of the hull where the sides meet the bottom

Cleat: a two-horned fitting for securing lines to the boat

Cockpit: the area of the boat behind the helm

Crankbait: a plug with a lip that causes it to dive

Cuddy: a small shelter cabin in a boat

Deadrise: the angle of the bottom of the hull near the transom

Depthfinder: a sonar device used to read the bottom structure, determine depth, and in some cases actually spot the fish; also called a fishfinder

Deck: the floor of the boat

Dock: the protected area where boats are moored

Downwind: moving with the wind

Draft: the distance from the waterline to the lowest point of the boat

Freeboard: the distance from the waterline to the gurwale Game Fish: a fish that is regulated by law for recreational harvest

Gel Coat: the exterior finish on a fiberglass boat

Gunwale: the top edge of the boat's sides

Helm: the wheel or tiller that steers the boat

Horsepower: a unit of measurement used to determine power and output of an engine

Hull: the main body of the boat, not including the interior or deck

Inboard/Outboard (I/O): a propulsion system that combines an inboard engine with an outboard drive unit

Jig: a hook with a lead head that is usually dressed with hair, silicone or plastic

Keel: the bottom center of the hull, running the entire length

Keeper: any fish that conforms to a specific minimum length limit established by the state fisheries department

Lipless Crankbaits: artificial baits that may vibrate, wobble and/or rattle, designed to resemble a swimming baitfish

Livewell: a container filled with water and often equipped with accessories such as lighting and aeration, used to hold and transport live fish


Midship: approximately equal distance between the bow and stern

Moor, to secure a boat with lines

Nautical Mile: Approximately 6076 feet, about 1/8 longer than the statute mile of 5280 feet

Outboard: a detachable engine mounted on the stern of the boat

Personal Flotation Device (PFD): the official term for a life jacket



Planing: when a boat is moving over the top of the water rather than through the water

Port: the left side of the boat as you face forward

Propeller: the blades attached to the motor that propel the boat

Ramp: a term used to denote the launch/retrieve area for a boat

Running lights: lights that are required to be shown when you're underway between sundown and sunup

Spinnerbait: a type of artificial lure that consists of one or two rotating blades and either a straight or safety-pin style shaft dressed with material

Starboard: the right side of the boat as you face forward

Stern: the rear of the boat

Stow: to put an item in its proper place

Tiller: the handle for steering an outboard motor

Transom: the squared-off section of the stern

Trim: to adjust the running attitude of the boat by moving the drive unit up or down (out or in)

Trolling: a method of fishing where several lures are towed behind the boat and retrieved as strikes are made

Trolling Motor: a small electric fishing motor, typically mounted on the bow, that is used as a secondary means of propulsion, for boat positioning and to maneuver quietly in fishing areas

Underway: when the boat is moving and not moored or anchored

Upwind: moving against the wind

V-Hull or Vee-hull, a hull with a V-shaped bottom, designed to split the waves and soften the ride

Wake: the waves a boat leaves behind when it's moving

Walk-Through: the passageway through the windshield from the cockpit to the bow

Waterline: where the surface of the water meets the sides of the boat.

Winch: the revolving crank on a trailer allowing you to up-load your boat
